

Bermuda Better Energy Plan

How to respond to the consultation

It is easy to submit a response to the Regulatory Authority of Bermuda (RAB) consultation on Bermuda's future energy plan. This page explains how.

1 - Write your consultation response

Write your own response, or use our template. If you need help deciding what your response should focus on then read our guidance document. The template and guidance document are available from www.betterenergyplan.bm/support-our-proposal and BE Solar's office on Pitt's Bay Road. Responses will be published by the RAB, so please consider this as you write them.

You may include any points that you feel relevant in your response. Please include or refer to supporting evidence where possible. Those that focus on the following areas of the Bermuda Better Energy Plan (BBEP) are most likely to be considered by the RAB:

- ✓ The BBEP is more consistent with the purposes of the Electricity Act.
- ✓ The BBEP is more consistent with instructions given to the RAB by the minister to encourage the least-cost sources of reliable electricity.
- ✓ The BBEP uses technology that is in commercial use in other jurisdictions.
- ✓ Any other aspect of the assumptions, assessment methodology and conclusions set out in the BBEP.

You must follow the RAB's rules for your response to be accepted:

1. Include your full name, address, phone number and e-mail address.
2. Submit your response in MS Word or Adobe Acrobat format, or on paper.
3. Clearly mark your response as:
"Response to Consultation Document: Comments on IRP Bulk Generation Proposals"

2 - Submit your response

Email your response to electricity@RAB.bm, requesting written confirmation that it has been received.

You must submit your response before 5pm on 30th November 2018.
